

**Direction No. 02/2020 (Amended) : - Norms and Procedure for  
Constitution of Board of  
Studies.**

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**WHEREAS** Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act, 1998 (hereinafter in this Direction referred to as " the said Act" ) has been passed by the State Legislature to establish the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (hereinafter in this Direction referred to as "the University") for the purposes of ensuring proper and systematic instruction, teaching, training and research in modern Medicine and Indian system of Medicine and to have a balanced growth in the Health Sciences, so also to have uniformity in various courses in Health Sciences in the State;

**AND WHEREAS** as per sub-section (2) of section 32 of the said Act, the University shall have such faculties as prescribed by Statutes and as per Section 36(1) of the said Act, there shall be a Board of Studies for every subject or group of subjects as prescribed by Statutes;

**AND WHEREAS** there is no Statutes in existence regarding constitution of Faculties and Board of Studies as per sub-section (2) of section 32 and sub-section (1) of section 36 of the said Act

**AND WHEREAS** making of Statute is time taking process;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Lt Gen Madhuri Kanitkar (Retd), Vice-Chancellor of the University in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under sub-section (8) of section 16 of the said Act issue the following Direction, namely:-

**1. Short title, extent and commencement.-**

(1) This Direction may be called the norms and procedure for constitution of Board of Studies.

(2) It shall come into force prospective from the date of its issue.

- (3) It extends to all the existing affiliated private aided and non-aided colleges and recognized institutions.
- (4) The existing Direction No.01/2012 prescribing rules for constitution of Board of Studies is hereby repealed. However, the actions taken under the said Direction shall stand protected.

## **2. Faculties:-**

There shall be following faculties in the University;

- (1) Faculty of Medicine;
- (2) Faculty of Dentistry;
- (3) Faculty of Ayurved and Unani;
- (4) Faculty of Homeopathy;
- (5) Faculty of Nursing;
- (6) Faculty of Allied Health Sciences;
- (7) Such other Faculty as decided by the University from time to time.

## **3. Departments and corresponding Board of Studies:-**

- (1) The Board of Studies shall be constituted as per sub-section (2) of section 36 of the Act by adopting the appropriate procedure of election, nomination and co-option as decided by the University from time to time.
- (2) The eligibility conditions for being elected or nominated as a member of any Board of Studies shall be as published by the government in the Official Gazette, from time to time.
- (3) There shall be following Board of Studies for the Departments (subjects / group of subjects) in various faculties.

**4. Constitution, Powers and Functions of Ad-hoc Board of Studies:-**

(1) If there is no separate Board of Studies in any subject or group of subjects or University Department, the Vice-Chancellor shall have power to constitute an *Ad-hoc* Board of Studies in the subject or group of subjects.

(2) The *Ad-hoc* Board shall consist of the following members:

- a) One Head of the **each** concerned Dept. of the affiliated colleges or recognized institutions, nominated by the Vice-Chancellor,
- b) Chairman of the Board of Studies of the concerned broad specialty,
- c) four subject experts to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor,
- d) the Vice-Chancellor shall appoint one of the members as the Chairman of the *Ad-hoc* Board,

- (3) The *Ad-hoc* Board shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as of the powers and duties of the regular Board of Studies.
- (4) The term of the *Ad-hoc* Board of Studies shall be co-terminus with the term of the regular Board of Studies under the concerned faculty, or as defined by the University.
- (5) The Chairman of the *Ad-hoc* Board of Studies shall be member of the Academic Council. Such member shall have right to speak but shall not have rights to vote or contest any election being the member of the Academic Council.

**5. Miscellaneous:-**

- (1) No act of constitution of Board of Studies shall be deemed to be invalid at any time merely on the ground that there is any irregularity in the constitution process or any minor deviation made in any procedure, not affecting the merits of the case.
- (2) The Vice-Chancellor or Academic Council may, at any time, without giving notice, amend, alter or repeal any provision of this Direction.
- (3) The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final and binding in case of interpretation or difficulty in implementation of any rule of this direction.
- (4) This Direction shall remain in force until Statute is made in that behalf by the University and assented by Hon'ble Chancellor.
- (6) All the words or terms denoting any gender shall include all genders.
